By looking at the total cost of a given system we can assist councils to understand the best cost option with a clear understanding of each component of the total system.

FULL COST PRICING OF CURRENT SYSTEMS

The full cost of providing a service is a severe limiting factor in ensuring decisions are transparent. The full cost of councils existing system should take into account a return on its capital, as well as the costs of facility set up and ultimately rehabilitation. Any new facility or a review of other options are likely to be fully costed. Without a clear understanding of the actual cost of providing its current service (or the cost of increased environmental standards) a council can not make a decision to compare its service against other options.

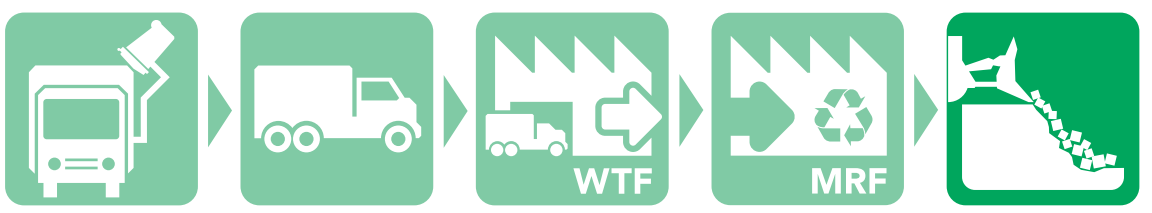
