## REGIONAL COLLABORATION

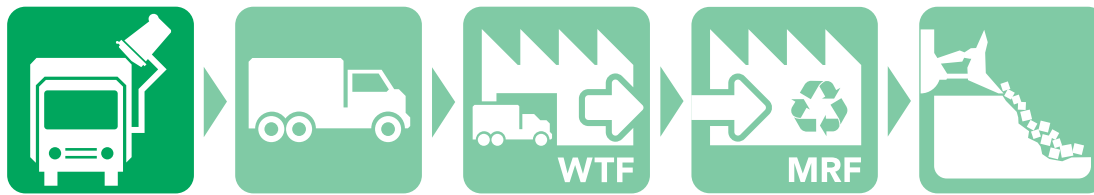
